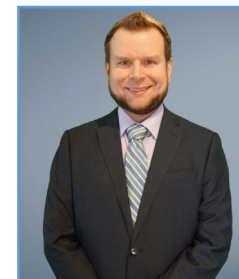

Out of all the choices we make, none are as important as those that impact our eternal souls. For instance, every day we can either choose to put our faith in the Savior who laid everything on the line for us, or we can pursue our own passions and depend on our own abilities and resources. Wisdom says that only one of those options is truly viable, because according to Proverbs 14:12, "There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way to death."
