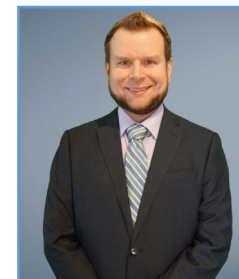

#6 – Joyful
