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Carl's Dye-a-logue

I have officially completed two weeks of cardiac rehab. Cardiac rehab is essentially going to a gym and doing cardio work. I walk on a treadmill, I ride a bike, and, just this past week, started rowing on a rowing machine.

One difference from a regular gym is registered nurses with over 100 years of cardiac nursing experience are watching your workout. These nurses are also taking attendance. If you do not show up, they will call you that same day to make sure everything is alright.

Another difference is that each time I go in, the first thing I do is put on a heart monitor. Throughout my workout, one of the nurses is monitoring my EKG, pulse, and several other heart related things. I also have my blood pressure taken at least three times while I am there: once before I workout, once during the course of my workout, and once about 10-15 minutes after my workout.

As usual, you may be wondering why I would tell you this? On August 20, 2022 I had a traumatic experience with my heart. If I want to avoid another traumatic experience, I had to change some things and the cardiologist recommended rehab.

We have some folks right here at Bell Avenue who have recently experienced a traumatic event spiritually speaking (i.e. sin). They may not need to go to rehab three days a week, but they do need some encouragement so that the "traumatic event" does not repeat itself.

As they work to get back in spiritual shape, they not only need to be encouraged, but monitored as well. We need to check on them regularly. If you notice they are not at church, they need to be called ASAP.

In Galatians 6:1, Paul wrote, "Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted."
